The 8 (a) Program provides federal government contracts and other assistance to small companies owned by socially and economically disadvantaged persons. The purposes of the 8 (a) Program are to foster business ownership and the competitive viability of firms owned by individuals who are socially and economically disadvantaged, and to expand their participation in federal procurement of equipment, products and services.

- To participate in the 8 (a) Program, a business must be at least 51 percent unconditionally owned by either:
- An individual (s) who is a socially and economically disadvantaged citizen of the United States or;
- An economically disadvantaged Indian tribe, including an Alaska native corporation or an economically disadvantaged native Hawaiian
